# O.R.E.O. Online Project 2018

## **Instruction Worksheet and Final Tally Information**

#### **Materials:**

- Regular O.R.E.O. cookies (not double stuff unless you wish to do the extension activity)
- Tablecloth or paper plates to stack cookies
- Pencil or pen to record amount of cookies after they have tumbled
- Attempt Worksheet
- Submission Form

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Each student will have 2 attempts to create a cookie stack.
- 2. Students will place **one** cookie on the paper plate/table cloth and **add one cookie at a time** to the stack.
- Students may NOT adjust the cookie after they have placed the cookie on the stack and moved their hand away. Cookies need to be freestanding and NOT leaning against any kind of support or use any kind of adhesion, so they stick together. Cookie needs to be a regular cookie and not separated in ANY way.
- 4. Another student should be tallying as the student stacks.
- 5. A tumble has occurred once **1** or more cookies have tumbled off the stack. The complete stack DOES not need to completely tumble for it to be called a tumble.
- 6. Once a tumble has occurred the student needs to record their stack count onto the attempt worksheet.
- 7. Whether the student attempts their second stack now or at another time is at the discretion of the teacher.
- 8. Once all students (and teacher too) recorded their stack totals, please add up all largest cookie stack attempts from each person and divide by amount of people who have stacked to determine average length stacked.
- 9. Please submit the class **AVERAGE LENGTH STACKED** via the online form (available on results page)
